Spirit Items	Suggested items to sell: knit hats (blue and pink), t-shirts (red, blue, gray), hooded sweatshirts (red, blue, gray)	Anne will contact Ron Morency and invite him to come and show us merchandise.
2006 budget	Anne presented a 2006 summary budget that projects \$14,820 in revenue, \$32,920 in expenses, and \$18,100 needed to fundraise. The board approved the expenses and the budget was approved. The majority of the meeting was spent discussing the registration fees for 2006. We voted to raise the high school fee to \$150 and keep the middle school fee at \$135. We discussed building a shed and possible asking Dr. Pound for a donation for it.	Anne will finalize budget. Barb will look into prices for sheds built by Lake Region High School students.
Pineland Trail Challenge	Anne gave out sponsorship/donation forms. We decided to charge \$5 for a meal ticket.
