Secretary's report	Minutes from 8/15/06 meeting were approved	
Treasurer's report	Anne reported our balance was looking healthy according to planned budget. Following this meeting, Anne reported a balance of \$20,988.88.	Anne will email Jenny account balance and updated budget.
Patriot Cheerleaders	Phil reported that he has 3 volunteer guards. The club voted to spend \$25 for 100 more signed autographs.
