Treasurer's report - Our balance is \$3,216.58. Since the last meeting, we had a deposit of \$126.80 from the Bottle Barn and \$175.00 for ink cartridges, which Verizon will match. Anne will make the May payment to Northeast this week. Anne is holding a check for \$250 from a Florida company toward the Patriots Cheerleader event.

Extra headset - Not planning on buying this year.

Shed update - Barney put in a formal request from Home Depot for materials. They need a 501(c)(3) certificate, which Barney will furnish this week. Barney will call Tammy regarding the possible shed donation by John Drew.

Summer camp - Need to decide on logo for shirts. The group reviewed several logos and decided on one that has the Patriots football player on it. Anne and Regina will come up with a couple possibilities and email them around to the group to choose. Gray tshirts with a navy logo will cost \$4.25 from Northeast Athletics. If we get 25 players to attend at \$25 each, pay two coaches \$125 each and buy tshirts for everyone, we should still make at least \$250.

Spirit Items - Will will take over the contact with Don Morency regarding club merchandise. We need to order the camp tshirts asap. We should decide on regular tshirt logos within the next two weeks so we can have them to sell at camp and for the players to wear during the bottle drive on July 8th. We can get gray tshirts with a one-color logo for \$4.25 and red or navy tshirts with a one-color logo for \$5.25. We could sell them for as low as \$8 and still have a good profit margin. We'll probably have our knit caps done by Tina White.

Bottle Drive - Barney will check out a redemption center in Portland that advertises that they cater to large loads.

Patriots Cheerleaders - no action. Phil was not at meeting.

Web site - Regina is updating the web site and wants to include all our sponsors and how long each has been donating to the Club. Anne and Barbara will get her the records of sponsors in 2003 and 2004.

Donation - Anne reported that Phil convinced Cook's Hardware to donate a bag of grass seed valued at \$21.99. Phil also bought a bag for us.

Fall Sports Information Night - The group decided to use white folders with white stickers again this year. We'll need to produce a new football registration form and a summer camp registration form. Anne will draft forms for the next meeting. Will will contact Geoff to see if he has set a date for info night yet.

Pineland Race Barbeque - Will got 100 bags of chips donated. We also have 10 pounds of hamburger from Right Time Cafe, plus paper products and condiments from Hannafords. Barney will call Phil DiRusso and check on registration numbers and any other product donations.
